

About COVID-19 Vaccinations

A You can receive your vaccine shots at public facilities during mass inoculations or individually through primary care physicians.

Vaccinations are by **appointment only**. Upon making an appointment for **your first vaccine shot**, an appointment for your **second shot** is automatically made for the **same location, same time slot exactly 3 weeks apart**.

■ Appointment/Vaccination Schedule

Appointments are open for those aged 60 and over, and those affected by underlying illnesses.

■ Instructions

① For those with illnesses, taking medication, or feeling nervous about the vaccine, please consult your doctor regarding your suitability.



② Choose your preferred vaccination site and date/time.

For a list of vaccination sites and available date/time, please refer to document No.3 「COVID-19 Vaccine Mass Inoculation sites」 and document No.4 「COVID-19 Vaccine A List of Available Medical Facilities」

※ Your preferred location/time maybe fully booked and unavailable.



③ Make appointment

See Document No.2 「Making an Appointment for COVID-19 Vaccination」 for instructions.



④ 「Appointment Confirmation」 containing your booked date and location will be mailed by the city 1 week before your vaccination date.



⑤ Go to your vaccination site on time.

■ What to Bring

- (1) Pre-vaccination Screening Questionnaire, filled and signed.
- (2) All documents in this letter, such as Vaccination Voucher. (Do not remove stickers)
- (3) Personal identification (Residence Card, Driver's License etc.)
- (4) Medicine Handbook (if you have one)
- (5) Appointment Confirmation (mailed 1 week before)

■ Please Read

- (1) The vaccine is injected into the left arm, please dress accordingly so that the left shoulder can be easily exposed. Avoid dress shirts and other articles of clothing which are difficult to remove.
- (2) Please wear a face mask.
- (3) Please take your temperature at home before arriving. (no need to fill in Pre-vaccination Screening Questionnaire)
- (4) If you feel ill, have a fever and/or have cold-like symptoms on the day of vaccination, please contact our call center (0256-33-8780)
- (5) The schedule is subject to changes. These will be announced through Koho Sanjo and the city's home page.

■ Discounted Taxi Service

Offered by taxi companies in Sanjo, for trips to and from vaccination site.
