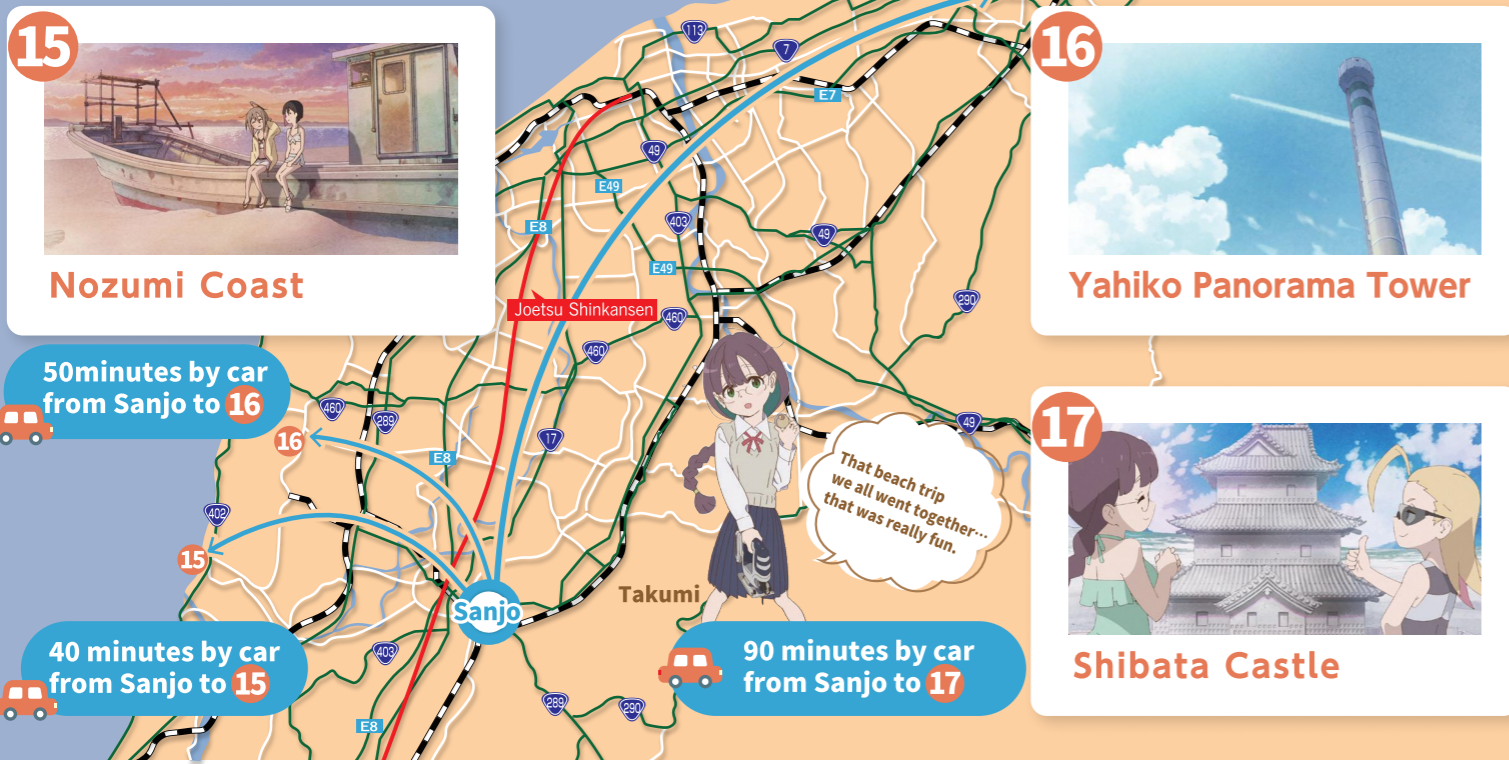

Fashionable cafes and an abundance of different stores line this shopping street located in the city's center.

### TREE

This traditional Japanese-style building-turned cafe is a popular gathering spot among locals.

**1 Hachiman Park**  
 Located directly next to Hachimangu Shrine, Kanayama Jinja Shrine, and a stone monument dedicated to the ancestral god of local industry, you can feel Japanese culture and local history at this power spot.

**2 Machiyama Library**  
 You can see a recreated tree house from the live-action drama on display here.

**3 Stage Engawa/ Sanjo Spice Lab**  
 Home to all kinds of events on weekends, this spot is loved by children and adults alike. Grabbing a bite to eat at the Sanjo Spice Lab inside is also highly recommended!

**4 Original Manhole Cover**  
 Feature an original manhole designed by the Niigata born animator Kato Kee.
